This Addendum is issued to clarify questions received from prospective proposers. This Addendum becomes part of the RFP and must be acknowledged in the proposer's submission.

Q1.

I am not currently set up as a corporation nor do I have the required insurance. While I plan to have those taken care of before work would commence, I will not have them in place by the RFP due date. Can I express the commitment to have those in place?

A1.

Yes. A proposer may submit a written commitment stating they will obtain all required insurance and business registration(s) prior to contract execution. Proof of compliance will be required before work begins.

Q2.

There is no specific term for the contract stated in the RFP. What is the Consortium's expectation? Would proposing a three-year agreement be advisable?

A2.

The Clean Water Consortium is a relatively new initiative working on long-term solutions. Current approved projects are expected to extend at least three years. Proposers may submit a proposed term, including a one-year or multi-year agreement. Proposers should provide monthly rate information and identify any minimum contractual term required.

All other terms and conditions of the original RFP remain unchanged.
