Morrow County is seeking pricing and availability information for portable/rolling aluminum bleachers suitable for outdoor public use. Specifically, we are interested in bleachers that meet the following general requirements:

Specifications

- **Height/Size:** Approximately 10 rows (10 seats high)
- **Capacity:** 100–200 seats, depending on length (16 ft. per section preferred; alternate lengths welcome)
- **Portability:** Must be transportable/rolling, either with an integrated wheel system or compatible with a mover kit (e.g., tractor/skid steer or equivalent)

Construction Requirements

- **All-aluminum frame and seat planks**
- **Double footboards for each row**
- **Guardrail system (picket or chain-link style)**
- **Center aisle with handrail preferred**
- **Outdoor weather-resistant materials suitable for Oregon's climate**

Code Compliance

All bleacher units must be fully compliant with applicable codes and safety standards, including:

- Bleacher systems must meet all current applicable building, safety, and accessibility codes for public assembly structures.
 - Guardrail and egress standards:
 - Minimum 42-inch guardrail height
 - Maximum 4-inch opening restriction
 - Proper aisle widths and egress per current IBC guidelines
