ORDINANCE NUMBER MC-C-5-99

The County of Morrow does ordain as follows;

WHEREAS, the Morrow County Planning Commission reviewed the combined Land Partition and Comprehensive Plan Amendment application filed by Morrow County and Eugene Majeske, for property located in the Clarks Canyon area at the intersection of Clarks and Fuller Canyon Roads; and

WHEREAS, the Morrow County Planning Commission held public hearings on August 30, 1999 at Irrigon, Oregon and September 27, 1999 at Lexington, Oregon;

WHEREAS, the Morrow County Planning Commission voted unanimously to approve the Land Partition to partition a 44 acre "non-farm" parcel from the parent parcel, and to amend the comprehensive plan to include the 44-acre parcel on the Goal 5 aggregate inventory as a "significant resource"; and

WHEREAS, the Morrow County Court reviewed the recommendation for approval by the Morrow County Planning Commission and voted unanimously to uphold the decision of the Planning Commission; and

WHEREAS, the Morrow County Court held a public hearing on October 6, 1999 at Heppner, Oregon.

NOW THEREFORE, THE COUNTY COURT OF MORROW COUNTY ORDAINS AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. TITLE OF ORDINANCE.

This ordinance shall be known, and may be cited as, "the Comprehensive Plan Goal 5 Amendment for the "Morrow County/Clarks Canyon Aggregate Site".

SECTION 2. TEXT AMENDMENT.

Amend page 102 of Comprehensive Plan to include:

"Morrow County/Clarks Canyon Site" located on tax lot 1702 of Assessor's Map 2S 25, a 44.0 acre parcel, a "significant resource."

SECTION 3. EFFECTIVE DATE.

This Ordinance being necessary to carry out the intent of the use of the land and to fulfill landowner obligations made pursuant to understanding effect of the zone change, an emergency is declared to exist and the ordinance shall be effective immediately upon its passage by unanimous vote of the Morrow County Court, it being in the best interest and welfare of the people of Morrow County.
