WHEREAS, Oregon Revised Statutes Chapter 92, Section 050 establishes survey requirements for subdivisions and land partitions; and

WHEREAS, Oregon Revised Statutes Chapter 92, Section 025(3) allows a County to waive the requirement that parcels created in excess of 80 acres be shown on a partition plat; and

WHEREAS, the Morrow County Subdivision Ordinance should be consistent with the Oregon Revised Statutes Chapter 92; and

WHEREAS, the Morrow County Court has reviewed the recommendation for approval by the Morrow County Planning Commission; and

WHEREAS, the Morrow County Planning Commission held public hearings on January 31, 2000 at Lexington, Oregon and February 28, 2000, at Irrigon, Oregon;

NOW THEREFORE, be it ordered by the Morrow County Court, that the attached Subdivision Ordinance Amendment marked Exhibit "A", amending the Morrow County Subdivision Ordinance, is hereby made a part of the Morrow County Subdivision Ordinance.

As it is necessary for the health, welfare, safety and convenience of the citizens of Morrow County, an emergency exists and this ordinance shall take effect immediately upon unanimous vote of the County Court and attestation by the County Clerk.

Section 5.070. FINAL PLAT MAP FOR PARTITIONING. Following commission approval of the Tentative Plan for a proposed partitioning, the person proposing the subject partitioning shall prepare and submit to the Planning Department the final plat map for the subject partitioning. The survey must be prepared by a licensed Oregon land surveyor. Such filing shall be completed within one year from the date of the Commission action or the approval of the partitioning shall expire and said approval shall be declared null and void. The final plat shall be prepared in accordance with the following requirements, two (2) copies thereof submitted to the Planning Director for approval, and the original recorded in the office of the county Clerk following approval by the County Planning Director. Copies of said final map shall be provided by the partitioner without cost to the County Assessor, County Surveyor and County Planning Director.

(1) Final plat map requirements:

(3) Parcels created in excess of 80 acres do not need to be shown on a partition plat.
