
## CERTIFIED RECORD OF LAND CORNER MONUMENTATION

## History of original corner establishment:

This corner was originally established by David P. Thompson under G.L.O. contract number 122, dated June 13, 1867. Survey General notes state:

Set post for corner to secs 1,2,11&12 in mound of Earth with charred stake & pits as per instructions.



## Description of corner evidence found:

Accepted a long standing south and east fence corner.

## original location of this corner: Description of monument and accessories I establish to perpetuate the

At the position of the above said fence corner, set a 2-1/2"dia.x 30" aluminum pipe w/3"dia. aluminum cap, stamped as shown in the DIAGRAM, 26" in the ground, from which;

A 5/8"x 30" rebar pin bears N45°W 15.7 ft. Top is set 1 foot below ground, with no marks on top of pin.

 $\triangleright$ 5/8"x 30" rebar pin bears N45°E 19.8 ft. Top is set 1 foot below ground, filed one groove on top of pin

 $\triangleright$ 5/8"x 30" rebar pin bears S45°E 13.1 ft. is set 27" deep, filed 2 grooves on top of pin.

A 5/8"x 30" rebar pin bears S45°W 17.3 ft. is set 30" deep, filed an X on top of pin
