

The corner was originally set by David P. Thompson under contract 109 dated January 30, 1865. His record reads: Set a post for corner to Secs 9, 10, 15 &16 in mound of earth with charred stake, pits, &c. as per instructions.

Monument and Accessories found: (condition and source) None. This position falls in a plowed field.

MONUMENT (S) AND ACCESSORIES SET (Procedures and Description)

I set a 2 3/8" brass cap on a 1 1/2" x 30" galvanized iron pipe 54 inches in the ground at the point determined by proportioning the departure along the projected centerline of Smith Road

as per the county road notes. The cap is stamped as shown in the diagram above.

For references, I set four, 5/8" by 24" rebars with 1.25" orange plastic caps stamped WTS and

56295LS as described below: an iron rebar bears N45°42'42"W, 29.02 feet, 20 inches below the surface; an iron rebar bears N37°22'07"E, 26.84 feet, 20 inches below the surface; an iron rebar bears S56°03'55"E, 24.85 feet, 20 inches below the surface; an iron rebar bears S36°18'28"W, 27.33 feet, 20 inches below the surface;

Measurements were made with a Trimble RTK GPS.
