

MONUMENT (S) AND ACCESSORIES SET (Procedures and Description)
I held the existing fence and plow berm for latitude and proportioned the departure.

For references, I set four, 5/8" by 24" rebars with 1.25" orange plastic caps stamped WTS and 56295LS as described below:

an iron rebar bears N00°04'28"W, 23.20 feet 12 inches below the surface;

an iron rebar bears N86°36'17"W, 24.58 feet;

an iron rebar bears N86°59'35"E, 27.19 feet;

an iron rebar bears S01°37'08"W, 24.51 feet 12 inches below the surface;
