

Corner originally set by B.J. Pengra under contract No. 119 dated February 15, 1867. His record reads: Set stone, 13x9x6 inches as 1/4 section corner.

Monument and Accessories found: (condition and source) None. The point falls in the edge of a CRP field.



MONUMENT (S) AND ACCESSORIES SET (Procedures and Description) At the proportioned point I set a 2 3/8" brass cap on a 1 1/2"x30" galvanized iron pipe 30 inches in the ground. The cap is stamped as shown in the diagram above.

For references, I set four 5/8" by 24" rebars with 1.25" orange plastic caps stamped WTS and 56295LS as described below:

an iron rebar bears N82°39'28"E, 21.84 feet 12 inches below the surface;

an iron rebar bears S19°28'01"E, 20.31 feet 12 inches below the surface;

an iron rebar bears S68°46'49"W, 30.36 feet under the existing fence;

an iron rebar bears N16°42'21"W, 22.96 feet under the existing fence;

a stone 3 ft. x 3 ft. x 18 ins. above ground marked "XBO" on top bears N59°06'35"W, 28.26 feet;

The monument and references were tied using a Trimble R7/R8 RTK GPS system.
