

Previous Renewals / Surveys, etc.

Corner originally set by B. J. Pengra under contract No. 119 dated February 15, 1867. His record reads: Set quarter section post. Drove charred stake in raised mound. Prior to 1912 D.V.S. Reid found the original mound, pits, and charred stake and drove a 3/8"x36" smooth iron rod at the corner point. (See folder 1123) Then, in 1912 Mr. Reid added a stone 23x10x5 inches marked C.S. on the south side of the rod and made an earth mound 18 inches high and 3 feet diameter over the corner. Reid also made four references as follows: NE 12 links, a brick; NW 12 links, a flat iron; SW 12 links, fine stone coal with a 1 1/4" galvanized iron pipe; SE 12 links, broken clear clear glass; In 2002 Judson Coppock claimed to have set a brass cap by proportion at this corner. (See folder 1335.)

Monument and Accessories found: (condition and source)

A basalt stone 18x9x6 ins. on the south side of a 3/8" smooth iron rod. I also found Reid's iron pipe reference to the southwest.



MONUMENT (S) AND ACCESSORIES SET (Procedures and Description) At the position of Reid's iron rod I set a 2 3/8" brass cap on a 1 1/2" galvanized iron pipe flush with the surface over the iron rod. I left the stone in place undisturbed. The brass cap by Coppock

For references, I set three 5/8" by 24" rebars with 1 1/8" orange plastic caps stamped WTS and 56295LS as follows:

an iron rebar bears N89°53'00"W, 38.72 feet under the existing fence;

an iron rebar bears N12°00'27"E, 48.97 feet at the foot of an 8 inch well casing;

an iron rebar bears N89°22'13"E, 32.53 feet at the southwest leg of a rock jack;

the iron pipe by Reid bears S38°10'50"W, 8.04 feet.

the computed point by Coppock bears N50°38'47"E, 14.56 feet more or less.

The monument and references were tied using a Trimble R7/R8 RTK GPS.
