

Previous Renewals / Surveys, etc.

Corner originally set by David P. Thompson under contract No. 122 dated June 13, 1867. His record reads: Set a stone 16x10x8 inches as corner to sections 4, 5, 8 & 9. In 1914 Loy Turner in survey 1130A found a stone he said "tallied with the field notes as the original stone" in a pile of rocks in the fence corner. Mr. Turner held this point to proportion the 1/4 corner to the north.

Monument and Accessories found: (condition and source)

A three way fence corner with a gate in each direction creating 4 rock jacks within a circle of about 20 feet radius. I searched the 4 rock jacks and did not find a marked stone.



MONUMENT (S) AND ACCESSORIES SET (Procedures and Description) I held the fence corner reported by County Surveyor Loy Turner.

For references, I set four 5/8" by 24" rebars with 1 1/8" orange plastic caps stamped WTS and 56295LS as follows:

an iron rebar bears N77°33'22"W, 48.46 feet, flush with the surface in a small mound of earth; an iron rebar bears N10°26'11"W, 75.49 feet, flush with the surface in a small mound of earth; an iron rebar bears N00°57'34"E, 175.24 feet, flush with the surface in the edge of a plow berm; an iron rebar bears S38°13'52"E, 65.30 feet, flush with the surface under the existing fence;

The monument and references were tied using a Trimble R7/R8 RTK GPS.
