

FOUND A STONE OF SAME DIMENSIONS, WITH A FEW STONES AROUND IT LYING ON A GRASSY HILLSIDE JUST WEST OF HWY 74. THERE WERE NO OTHER STONES, OR MOUNDS IN THE IMMEDIATE AREA. VERY FEW STONES IN THIS OVERALL AREA, EXCEPT NEAR THE HWY R-O-W. APPEARED TO BE ONE NOTCH ON THE TOP OF THE STONE.
