## Original corner evidence recovered:

Found the original corner stone loosely set on the east edge of a mound of stones. It original corner stone is  $28" \times 8" \times 5"$  and is plainly marked with three notches on one (south) edge and two notches on another (east) edge.

Monument and accessories established to perpetuate the original position of this

mound of stones around the pipe. A 2 1/2" brass cap attached to the top of the pipe is ground to bedrock. I place a non-functioning pocket watch at the base of the monument In place of the corner stone, I set a 1" x 18" flared, galvanized iron pipe 16" into the marked as shown in the diagram above, from which: as a memorial and bury the corner stone along the northeast side of the pipe and build a

A 5/8" x 24" iron rod set 23" into the ground with a 3/4" brass washer, marked "PLS 14", attached at ground level, bears N31° E, 94.6 feet. 1636

A  $5/8" \times 24"$  iron rod set 23" into the ground with a 3/4" brass washer, marked "PLS 163623", attached at ground level, bears S58° E, 152.6 feet.

to capture spring water in ponds. The above two references are about 10 to 20 feet west of small earth dams constructed

A 5/8" × 24" 8" x 24" iron rod set 23" into the ground with a 3/4" brass washer, marked "PLS 1636 attached at ground level, bears S30° 30' W, 94.1 feet.

A  $5/8" \times 24"$  iron rod set 23" into the ground with a 3/4" brass washer, marked "PLS 15", attached at ground level, bears N41° 30' W, 108.9 feet. 1636
