pipe is marked as shown in the diagram above, from which: In place of the corner stone, I set a  $1" \times 18"$  flared, galvanized iron pipe 15" into the ground to bedrock. I bury the original corner stone along the north side of the pipe and build a mound of stones around the pipe. A 2 1/2" brass cap attached to the top of the
