Original corner evidence recovered:

Found the original corner stone solidly set in a mound of stones. and is marked "1/4" on the south face The corner stone is

ground. I bury the corner stone along the east side of the pipe and build a mound of stones around the pipe. A 2 1/2" brass cap attached to the top of the pipe is marked as shown in the diagram above, from which: In place of the corner stone, I set a 1" x 18" flared, galvanized iron pipe 16" into the

A 5/8" x 18" iron rod set 17" into the ground, with a 3/4" brass washer, marked "PLS 1636 NE", attached at ground level, bears N33° E, 78.3 feet.


A 5/8" x 18" iron rod set 17" into the ground with a 3/4" brass washer, marked "PLS 1636 SE", attached at ground level, bears S42° E, 88.4 feet.

A 5/8" x 18" iron rod set 17" into the ground with a 3/4" brass washer, marked "PLS A 5/8" x 18" iron rod set 17" into the ground with a 3/4" brass washer, marked "PLS

1636 SW", attached at ground level, bears S9° 30' W, 67.6 feet. A 5/8" x 18" iron rod set 16" into the ground with a 3/4" brass washer, marked "PLS 1636 NW", attached at ground level, bears N70° 30' W, 80.2 feet.
