
History of original corner establishment:

We recover the iron rod set by Fraley, Map of Survey C-198-K

Description of monument and accessories I establish to perpetuate the original location of this corner:

At the position of the said iron rod, set a 2-1/2" dia. x 30" steel pipe monument w/3" dia. brass cap stamped as shown in the DIAGRAM, 5" below the road grade, in a cast iron monument box, from which:

A 5/8" iron pin bears N00°13'01"W, 20.00 ft., R/W pin Sta. 57+71.94, 20' Lt. A 5/8" iron pin bears S00°13'01"E, 30.00 ft., R/W pin Sta. 57+71.94, 30' Rt.
