

## Description of corner evidence found:

We recover the railroad spike set by Tuers in 1975.

## Description of monument and accessories I establish to perpetuate the original location of this corner:

At the position of the said railroad spike, set a 2-1/2" dia. x 30" steel pipe monument w/3" dia. brass cap stamped as shown in the DIAGRAM, 5" below the road grade, in a cast iron monument box, from which:

A 5/8" iron pin bears N00°28'22"E, 20.00 ft., R/W pin Sta. 169+37.96, 20' Lt. A 5/8" iron pin bears S00°28'22"W, 30.00 ft., R/W pin Sta. 169+37.96, 30' Rt.
