
## **CERTIFIED RECORD OF LAND CORNER MONUMENTATION**

## History of original corner establishment:

This corner was originally established by John B. David under G.L.O. contract No. 131, dated June 8, 1869. Survey General notes state:

Set post in mound as per instructions for corner to Secs 16, 17, 20, 21.



## Description of corner evidence found:

Found  $\bar{a}$  5/8" iron pin at the record position of the corner. Accepted as the best available evidence of the corner location.

## Description of monument and accessories I establish to perpetuate the original location of this corner:

At the position of the said 5/8" pin, set a 2-1/2" dia. x 30" steel pipe monument w/3" dia. brass cap stamped as shown in the DIAGRAM, 5" below the road grade, in a cast iron monument box, from which:

A 5/8" iron pin bears N00°48'44"W, 30.00 ft., R/W pin Sta. 248+84.38, 20' Lt. A 5/8" iron pin bears S00°48'44"E, 20.00 ft., R/W pin Sta. 248+84.38, 20' Rt. A Brass Cap bears S44°30'29"W, 28.29 ft.
