History of Original Corner Establishment:

The corner was first established in 1869 by J. B. David in Original GLO Survey of Township 4 North, Range, 26 East under Contract No. 131. Record Reads: Set Post in Mound for Corner of Sections 5, 6, 7, & 8. O. O. Gould completed a Dependent Resurvey in 1939. Record Reads: Set Brass Cap on 2" x 36" Iron Post.

Description of evidence found:

Found 2 1/2" Brass Cap on 2" x 36" Iron Pipe buried 4 feet in ground & Set by O. O. Gould under GLO Dependent Survey in 1939. The Brass Cap fell in the center of alignment for a Proposed Roadway and would be Destroyed by Construction.

Description of monumentation and accessories established to perpetuate the location of this Section Corner:

I Referenced and Removed the GLO Monument Set by O. O. Gould Prior to Construction. After Construction I Reset the Monument at the Referenced Corner Location inside an Aluminum Monument Box in the Center Line of the Completed Road, Lewis & Clark Drive.

In addition, the following Bearing Objects were Tagged with Bearing Object Placards and a Washer Stamped PLS 2431 as follows, or as described: All Bearings & Distances are to the Center of the Washer or Plastic/Alum. Cap as Described.

- 1 A 5/8" Rebar w/ Plasic Cap #951 bears N 0° 04' 12" E 306.58 feet. Edwards (#951) Placard left in place.
- 2 A Steel Pole for Street Light bears N 67° 55' 47" E 76.65 feet.
- 3 A 5/8" Rebar w/Alum. Cap in C.L. Asphalt, Port of Morrow Control #2431 bears N 89° 08' 32" E 45.91 ft. (Placard not Posted)
- 4 A Wood Power Pole bears S 06° 29' 55" E 45.00 feet.
- 5 A Steel Pole for Street Light bears S 78° 00' 55" W 163.03 feet.
- 6 A 5/8" Rebar w/Plasic Cap #951 bears N 41° 56' 52" W 419.06 feet. Edwards (#951) Placard left in place.
