

History of original corner establishment:

This corner was originally established by John B. David under G.L.O. contract No. 131, dated June 8, 1869. Survey General notes state:

Set post in mound as per instructions for 1/4 Sec. corner.

In 1939, Otis Gould, under special instructions dated January 26, 1938, set a GLO brass cap monument at proportionate measure. The field notes state:



40.09 1/2 Proportionate measurement. Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. diam., 27 ins. in the ground, for 1/4 sec. cor.

In 1987, The Army Corps. of Engineers performed a partial boundary survey of the Umatilla Depot, titled "Umatilla Depot Activity, Boundary Survey". The monumentation notes state:

A-2=11-1=1/4 S.13 / S24

Replaced bent 1939 G.L.O. Cap and Pipe in position of undisturbed portion of pipe.

Description of corner evidence found:

No evidence of this corner is found. Set monument at the record position as returned on the 1987 Army Corps. of Engineer's Depot Survey.

Description of monument and accessories I establish to perpetuate the original location of this corner:

At the record position determined by survey, Set a $2-1/2" \times 30"$ aluminum pipe monument with 3" dia. cap stamped as shown in the DIAGRAM, 28" in the ground, from which:

A 5/8" rebar pin bears N39°25'00"W, 19.72 ft.

A 5/8" rebar pin with 1 groove filed on the top, bears N51°34'23"E, 18.53 ft.

A 5/8" rebar pin with 2 grooves filed on the top, bears S41°32'34"E, 18.42 ft.

A 5/8" rebar pin with 3 grooves filed on the top, bears S51°38'43"W, 18.97 ft.

Placed an orange plastic cap marked "FS&E Survey Marker" on all rebar pins. Set a green steel "T" post with white top 1 ft. north of monument.
