

was firmly in place with the 1/4 on the west face Found the stone plainly chisled 1/4 with one other stone set on a bare area of thin soil. The stone

I set a PK nail in the bedrock approximately 1 foot below the MONUMENT (S) AND ACCESSORIES SET (Procedures and Description) Set a 1 1/4" x 30" Galvanized Iron Pipe with a 2 1/2" brass cap stamped a shown in the diagram The original stone was burried in the mound at the foot of the pipe surface and set the brass cap over the top of it and built a stone mound around the monument.
