
RECORD OF LAND CORNER MONUMENTATION

SOUTHEAST 1/16 CORNER SECTION 21, T. 4 S., R. 28 E., W.M.

ORIGINALLY ESTABLISHED BY: Douglas M. Ferguson, PLS 848

COUNTY SURVEYOR DOCUMENTATION: Map of Survey recorded 1/10/86 as D-802-K-652 and associated monumentation record filed 1/10/86



ORIGINAL DESCRIPTION: Set 2-1/2"x30" aluminum pipe with 2-1/2" aluminum cap, stamped as shown on the DIAGRAM, set 23" in the ground. From which,

A Spruce, 12" dia. Bears, S42°W., 37.8 ft., scribed: SE 1/16 S21 BT A Spruce, 16" dia. Bears, N46°W., 18.2 ft., scribed: SE 1/16 S21 BT

EVIDENCE FOUND: Found a $2\frac{1}{2}$ " aluminum pipe with $2\frac{1}{2}$ " aluminum cap projecting 7" above ground. Also found the dead and down remains of both bearing trees.

DESCRIPTION OF MONUMENTS AND ACCESSORIES SET AND METHODS USED: I accept the found aluminum monument for the true corner position.

From which, I SCRIBE THE FOLLOWING NEW BEARING TREES:

- ► A lodgepole pine, 5" dbh bears N.7°E., 16.2 ft. marked "SE1/16 S21" in upper blaze and "BT" in lower blaze
- ► A white fir, 8" dbh bears S.74°W., 12.40 ft. marked "SE1/16 S21" in upper blaze and "BT" in lower blaze

Painted a 6 inch red band around the bearing trees, and also painted the blazes red and attached USFS signs 54-3 and 54-9. Distances measured with a steel tape, to a steel spike set in the right-side-center at the root crown of each tree. Bearings were measured with a magnetic compass with 14° East declination.
