

Description of corner evidence found:

None.

Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the original location of this corner:

At the corner point I set a 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 30" alum. pipe with a 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " alum. cap containing a magnet and marked:

Monument is 25" in the ground..

From the corner:

A White Fir, 25" dia., 5 $\frac{1}{4}$ "W, 71.8 ft.; marked: CWL/16 S33 BT

A White Fir, 19" dia., S78 $\frac{1}{4}$ E, 37.3 ft.; marked: CWI/16 S33 BT

BTs have blaze and a 6" band painted red; BT tags, "Land Survey Monument" signs and alum. "PLS 1832" washers nailed to the bottom of the blaze. There is a 6' steel fence post with a "Land Survey Monument" sign within 5' of the corner.

Measured to center of BTs using steel tape and staff compass. Magnetic declination set at 17°E.
