

Corner originally established by Edward W. Sanderson under GLO contract number 417, dated August 24, 1881. Surveyor General record states: Set sandstone 18x10x8 ins 12 ins in ground for cor to sees 7,8,17 and 18 marked mith 4 notches on S and 5 notches on E. edges, from which:




