
CERTIFIED RECORD OF LAND CORNER MONUMENTATION

History of original corner establishment:

1882 RECORD: Surveyed by E.W. Sanderson, 1882, Contract No. 417 40.00 set sandstone 18 \times 10 \times 3 ins 12 ins in ground from 1/4 sec cormarked 1/4 on W. face.

From which: A pine 10 i ins. diam bears N. 70° 90 lks. dist., marked 1/4 S 찚

A pine 28 ins. diam bears N. 75° W., 125 iks. dist. marked 1/4 S ВТ



Description of corner evidence found:

No Original monument found.

-Original pine stump 28" dia. bears N. 75° W., 82.5 feet (Old chopped open scar ax marks on piece of this stump found laying 10 feet from stump). We position cor. from this stump. tree was not logged as were others in the area.

-36" dia. pine with old K-Tag marked in 1929, 1949, 1955 on west (no ties on K-Tag) side bears N. 62° ₩.,

-Several blazed trees to north from a line leading over and t hought to be at least 50 years old. ç corner position as established. Blazes are grown

Corner is at edge of "old" road - approximately 30 feet north of Road 040.

position as determined by found, original N.W. B.T. set 3-1/4 inch PCl alum. cap $2\text{-}1/2 \times 30$ inch aluminim pipe 28 inches in the ground.

30 inch dia, mound of stone about corner.

54-3, and 54-9 or 54-4 signs on all bearing trees. Trees have red band and blazes are painted red. Brass washer nailed to BT portion of blaze on new bearing trees and on old bearing trees if needed. Steel guard post with 54-9 or 54-4 sign set 0 to 6 feet from corner. Distance measured in horizontal feet to center of tree. Bearings measured with magnetic compass, 20° East declination.
