

An 18" pine bears S- 4° W 102 Lks (67.3 ft) marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S BT.

No record of subsequent remo remonumentation found in County Records

Found 8" \times 10" \times 14" stone with "X" and $\frac{1}{4}$ chiseled on it from which: A $17\frac{1}{2}$ " dead ponderosa pine bears S 82° E, 115.3 feet, blaze rotted away. A 23" ponderosa pine bears S 35° W, 67.1 feet W, faint but illegible scribing.

original location of this corner Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate ÷

At the corner position a 2 inch by 30 inch iron pipe, with brass cap marked as shown, was set 18 inches in the ground and surrounded with a mound of stones to the cap.

Set steel fence post by corner and attached sign 54-4.

Established 2 new BT's:

A 12" bull pine bears \$ 79° E, 13.3 feet scribed 4 S 31 BT

An 11" bull pine bears S 77° W, 17.0 feet scribed $\frac{1}{4}$ S 36 BT. New BT's have a lower blaze scribed BT with a brass washer stamped PLS 1106 nailed flush. Attached signs 54–3 and 54–4 to all BT's and painted red ring around the trees above upper blaze.

Used steel tape and magnetic compass with 19½° See map of survey. east declination. Measured to center of Bts.
