
CERTIFIED RECORD OF LAND CORNER MONUMENTATION / RESTORATION

History of original corner establishment:

This corner was originally established by Timothy Davenport under G.L.O. contract No. 101, dated August 5, 1861. Survey General notes state:

Set post corner to Secs 32, 33, 28 & 29, made mound and drove charred stake as per instructions.

Donald Staebler set a brass disc in 1972 as shown on Umatilla County Map of Survey H-106-B.



Description of corner evidence found:

No evidence of this corner is found. Set monument at double proportionate measure.

Description of monument and accessories I establish to perpetuate the original location of this corner:

At proportionate position determined by survey, Set a $2-1/2" \times 30"$ aluminum pipe monument with 3" dia. cap stamped as shown in the DIAGRAM, 18" below the ground surface, from which:

A 5/8" rebar pin bears N55°32'57"W, 24.59 ft.

A 5/8" rebar pin with 1 groove filed on the top, bears N44°13′42″E, 20.12 ft.

A 5/8" rebar pin with 2 grooves filed on the top, bears S38°11'24"E, 30.15 ft.

A 5/8" rebar pin with 3 grooves filed on the top, bears S31°56'44"W, 53.18 ft.

Placed an orange plastic cap marked "FS&E Survey Marker" on all rebar pins. Set a green steel "T" post with white top 1.5 ft. north of monument.
