

A 15" Ponderosa Pine, scribed "T5S R26E S30 BT", bears N20° E, 60.9 feet. A 10" Ponderosa Pine, scribed "T5S R26E S31 BT", bears S57° 30' E, 145.7 feet. A 10" Ponderosa Pine, scribed "T5S R25E S36 BT", bears S70° 30' W, 138.8 feet. A 12" Ponderosa Pine, scribed "T5S R25E S25 BT", bears N5° 30' W, 72.5 feet.
