Found the original corner stone loosely set in a mound of stones. The corner stone is 14" x 10" x 6" and is marked with four grooves on one face and two grooves on the opposite face.

Monument and accessories established to perpetuate the original position of this corner

ground. In place of the original corner stone, I set a 1" x 30" flared, galvanized iron pipe 24" into the the pipe, from which: above. A wire fence projectiong east and west bears south, 1.0 foot
