History of original corner establishment:

The original corner was established by Everett A. Thatcher on August 17, 1879, under GLO contract No. 325, as follows:

Set a stone, 17" x 17" x 11", for the 1/4 section corner to sections 23 and 24, from which:

- A 36" pine bears S63° W, 49 links (32.34 feet).
- A 12" pine bears S28° E, 27 links (17.82 feet).

Original corner evidence recovered:

Found the original corner stone set 3" in the ground . The corner stone is 12" x 10" x 7" and is faintly marked with a "4" on one face. The witness trees of record are gone. This area has been logged many times in the past 50 years, and the bearing trees were likely destroyed. The corner stone is witnessed by a "Kinzua" location sign with the date "6-16-1954" inscribed on it.


Monument and accessories established to perpetuate the original position of this corner:

In place of the original corner stone, I set a 1" x 30" flared, galvanized iron pipe 25" into the ground. A 2 1/2" brass cap attached to the top of the pipe is marked as shown in the diagram above. I bury the corner stone along the south side of the pipe, from which:

- A 8" Douglas-fir, scribed "1/4 S24 BT", bears N54° E, 12.2 feet.
- A 7" Western Juniper, scribed "1/4 S24 BT", bears S62° E, 13.5 feet.
- A 10" Ponderosa Pine, scribed "1/4 S23 BT", bears S58° W, 24.6 feet. This tree has a "Bearing Tree" sign nailed above the blazes.
- A 9" Western Juniper, scribed "1/4 S23 BT", bears N50° W, 41.8 feet.

The new bearing trees are scribed on double blazes and have a 3/4" brass washer, marked "PLS 1636", nailed to the base of the lower blaze.

I hereby certify the above corner point was perpetuated as hereon described on June 16, 2004. Magnetic declination set in compass: 18° E.
