

ORIGINAL G.L.O. DESCRIPTION: Intersected N & S line 250 links North of Sec cor. on T. line and marked a pine 36 in. dia. for cor. to sec's. 1 & 12. T6S R25E. from which A Pine 36 in dia. S15*W. 69 lks

EVIDENCE FOUND: Found a 33" diam. x 6' tall buckskin stump with a partially healed blaze on the Southwesterly face with visible scribing: S, E 12; A partially healed blaze on Northwesterly face with visible scribing: 6 S (S is backwards) R25E S1. The East face also has visible scribing: T6 R26E. I also found the possible remains of the original bearing tree and root hole bearing S.15"W., approximately 45 feet distant to center of root hole. No discernible marking were found on the possible BT. There is a North-South wire fence on the west side of the marked pine stump Section Corner.

The found pine stump section corner bears N.00°02'48"W, a distance of 155.31 feet from the monumented Southwest corner of Section 6, T.6S., R.26E., W.M., which was perpetuated from found original GLO evidence.

DESCRIPTION OF MONUMENT AND ACCESSORIES SET:

No attempt was made to remonument the Section Corner as the corner position is occupied by the found pine stump. I established a Reference Monument S.00°02'48"E., a distance of 5.00 feet from the true corner position. At the Position for a Reference Monument, I set a 5/8"X30" iron pin with attached 3" aluminum cap, 26" in the ground. Cap is marked as shown below. Built a 2 ft. mound of stone around RM.


FROM THE TRUE SECTION CORNER POSITION, I set the following reference points:

A 5/8"x30" iron pin bears N.49*45'E., 22.77 ft., with attached yellow plastic cap marked BENCHMARK SURVEYING

A 5/8"x30" iron pin bears S.59°18'E., 20.97 ft., with attached yellow plastic cap marked BENCHMARK SURVEYING

A 5/8"x30" iron pin bears S.58°28'W., 21.88 ft., with attached yellow plastic cap marked BENCHMARK SURVEYING

A 5/8"x30" iron pin bears N.41°15'W., 27.25 ft., with attached yellow plastic cap marked BENCHMARK SURVEYING
