Found the original corner stone solidly set in a mound of stones. The corner stone i 17" x 12" x 5" and is faintly, but plainly marked "1/4" on the east face, from which: The corner stone is

A high cut 23" Ponderosa Pine stump with a healed blaze facing the corner stone and an open blaze with fragmentary scribes visible facing north, bears \$70° W, 11.9 feet to the blazed face. A 12" sawn Ponderosa Pine stump, no marks remaining, bears \$34° W, 11.9 feet to the assumed location of the blazed face.

# Monument and accessories established to perpetuate the original position of this corner:

ground. A 2 1/2" brass cap attached to the top of the pipe is marked as shown in the diagram above. "PLS 1636", nailed flush to the bottom of the lower blaze The new bearing trees are scribed on double blazes and have a 3/4" brass washer, marked
