A 24" sawn Douglas-fir stump with a healed lower blaze bears N 5° W, 22.8 feet. The badly decayed remains of a large Ponderosa Pine, root hole bears S45° E, 2 臣, 21. .0 feet.

Monument and accessories established to perpetuate the original position of this

I drive a $5/8" \times 24"$ iron rod into the center of the original corner tree so the top of the rod is flush to the top of the stump. I attach a 3/4" brass washer, marked "PLS 1636", to the rod, from which:

A 12" White Fir, scribed "1/4 S5 BT", bears N20° E, 32.4 feet.

A 9" Ponderosa Pine, scribed "1/4 S8 BT", bears S67° 30' E, 73.3 feet.

A 8" Ponderosa Pine, scribed "1/4 S8 BT", bears S30° W, 28.9 feet.

A 7" Ponderosa Pine, scribed "1/4 S5 BT", bears N53° 30' W, 25.7 feet.

marked "PLS 1636", nailed flush to the bottom of the lower blaze The new bearing trees are scribed on double blazes and have a 3/4" brass washer,
