Description of corner evidence found:

Nothing found after multiple search attempts.

Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the original location of this corner:

At position determined by survey, set a 2½" X 30" aluminum pipe with 3½" aluminum cap marked as shown in Corner Diagram set 24" above ground with magnet drilled into bedrock underneath. Construct mound of stone 5' in diameter around corner monument. From which:

A Juniper 18" in diameter bears N33°E, 39.6' scribed X BT.

A Juniper 20" in diameter bears S77°E, 31.8' scribed T6SR29ES34 BT.

A 5/8" X 30" rebar with 2" aluminum cap 6" above ground bears S33°W, 12.5'.

A stone in place 32" \times 26" \times 10" bears N15°W, 29.5' marked B \times 0 with MagNail at center of \times

Set aluminum fence posts 5" East and West of corner with 54-9 sign and 54-2 signs.

Distance to bearing trees measured to MagNail in right side center. Bearing trees have brass disk stamped PLS 2672 nailed between the B and T on lower face. Bearing trees have 54-3 and 54-9 signs, a 6" red painted band, and bearing tree face painted red. Distance to BO measured to center of MagNail. Bearings measured with hand compass, distances measured with steel tape.
