
## CERTIFIED RECORD OF LAND CORNER MONUMENTATION

T.7S., R.26E., INDEX A-11

History	of	original	corner	establishment:
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This corner was originally established by A.F. York under G.L.O. contract No. 309, dated Nov. 18, 1878. Survey General notes state:

Set stone 15x9x6 for 1/4 sec. cor. From which A yellow pine 30 in. in dia. bears N60°E, 12 lks dist. A yellow pine 36 in. in dia. bears S78°W, 108 lks dist.



## Description of corner evidence found:

No evidence of the original corner is recovered.

## Description of monument and accessories I establish to perpetuate the original location of this corner:

At proportionate position, Set a 2-1/2" dia.  $\times$  30" aluminum pipe monument  $\times$  3" dia. cap stamped as shown in the DIAGRAM, 26" in the ground, raised a 2' high  $\times$  4' dia. mound of stone, from which:

A 5/8" iron pin w/red "FS&E SURVEY MARKER" cap bears N48°33'W, 20.41 ft. A 5/8" iron pin w/red "FS&E SURVEY MARKER" cap bears N37°15'E, 18.08 ft. A 10" dia. Ponderosa Pine bears S64°43'E, 54.86 ft., scribed 1/4 S4 BT. A 10" dia. Ponderosa Pine bears S77°16'W, 53.91 ft., scribed 1/4 S4 BT.
