



#### NARRATIVE

The purpose of this survey was to establish various property lines for parcels which Columbia Basin Electric Cooperative plans to run boundaries along. Land to the south was based upon Morrow County Surveyors Drawing No. D-235-5 for the North Boundary, Ascent. The State Highway Commissioner, reported to the Morrow County Board of Trustees on November 16, 1955, that all of the State roads, the South line of the State property was established as being 1152 feet from the quarter corner and there of 62 to the section line the date given is of 3/2/55.

The East line also runs North parallel to the section line to the "2d 1/2" right as called to in the deed. This distance is longer than the other one, due

to the placement of the land, not the distance. An act of the Oregon State Legislature of 1855.

The Morrow County Road is well defined and shows on the records as a 60 foot

right of way. The Southern spur of Section 27 was broken down from the date mentioned above and a line to the Southern section corner which is a new rector set in 1955 by the County Surveyor Drawing No. D-235-5.
