Griffith registered land surveyor in the State of Oregon hereby certify that this plat and notes hereon, or attached are a true and correct representation of the survey made in July 1989 at the request of USDA Forest Service in accordance with the statutes of the State of Oregon and with the articles of my contract. retraced the area as shown on the annexed map.

Most of the corners had been found and monumented by others. See History of Surveys, hereon. The 1/4 corner to sections 17 and 18 was searched, the proportionate position is at the toe of a Forest Service road. No evidence was found. Sandersons notes running North between sections 17 and 18 call the brook at 39.75 chains. This appears to be an error, probably 5 chains. The brook is at 34.95 chains. The rest of the topo calls fit very well. The north 1/4 corner of section 18 was found as indicated. Sandersons calls to the range line are phony!

The North 1/4 corner of section 17 was remonumented by survey by Duane I, Griffith PLS 644 in II-75

The Northeast corner, the Southeast corner, the South 1/4

17 were remonumented from original GLO Survey evidence by Craig L. Wanless BLM, Group number 350 in 9-77. Under instructions dated May 3, 1957.

The South 1/4 corner of section 17 was remonumented from the new bearing trees as established by Craig L. Wanless BLM, in 9-77, by Douglas M. Ferguson PLS 848
