

## NARRATIVE:

THE PURPOSE OF THIS SURVEY IS TO STAKE THE FOUR CORNERS OF LOTS 9, 10, 11, AND 12, BLOCK 28, TOWN, NOW CITY OF

IRRIGON, SO A NEW FENCE CAN BE BUILT.

MONUMENTS WITH IVAN DRIVER'S SURVEYOR # WERE FOUND AT THE NE AND SE CORNERS OF THIS BLOCK, BUT, NO RECORD OF HIS SURVEY CAN BE FOUND. I USED SMOOTH IRON RODS, WHICH WERE SET IN THE 1960'S BY AN UNKNOWN SURVEYOR (ACCORDING TO FORMER MAYOR DON EPPENBACH) FOR THE CITY OF IRRIGON. THOSE IRON RODS FIT QUITE WELL WITH ONE ANOTHER, BUT MISS DRIVER'S MONUMENTS BY FROM 0.2 FEET TO 0.9 FEET.

THE OLD PLAT OF IRRIGON DID NOT SHOW ANY BEARINGS, SO I ASSUMED THE BEARING OF THE MONUMENTS ALONG THE SOUTH SIDE OF OREGON AVENUE TO BE WEST.
