


NARRATIVE:

THE PURPOSE OF THIS SURVEY IS TO REPLACE THE SOUTHWEST CORNER OF LOT 5, BLOCK 36, "TOWN OF IRRIGON" WHICH WAS OBLITERATED DURING WATER LINE INSTALLATION.

I BASED THIS SURVEY ON ONE I DID FOR THE THE SEVENTH DAY ADVENTIST CHURCH IN 1982.

THE SMOOTH 1/2" IRON RODS I FOUND WERE SET BY AN UNKNOWN SURVEYOR IN THE 1960'S AT ALL STREET AND ALLEY CORNERS FOR THE CITY OF IRRIGON AND THERE IS NO RECORD FILED AT THE COUNTY SURVEYORS OFFICE.
