FENCES RUN NORTH AND WEST FROM THE CORNER LOCATION. SET 2-1/2" ALUMINUM CAP ON A 5/8" X 30" REBAR FLUSH WITH GROUND SURFACE. ALSO SET 5/8" X 30" REBAR WITH YELLOW PLASTIC CAP INSCRIBED "B BESEDA PLS 50800" AS REFERENCES AS FOLLOWS:

THIS CORNER IS THE CENTER 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 24. IT WAS NOT ESTABLISHED IN THE ORIGINAL GLO SURVEY AND HAS NOT BEEN SET IN SUBSEQUENT SURVEYS. THIS SURVEY ESTABLISHED THE POSITION OF THIS CORNER AT THE INTERSECTION OF LINES DRAWN BETWEEN THE OPPOSING 1/4 CORNERS. SET A 2-1/2" ALUMINUM CAP ON A 5/8" X 30" REBAR 2 FEET BELOW GROUND SURFACE. ALSO SET 5/8" X 30" REBAR WITH YELLOW PLASTIC CAP INSCRIBED "B BESEDA PLS 50800" AS REFERENCES AS FOLLOWS:

NARRATIVE:

THE PURPOSE OF THIS SURVEY WAS TO ESTABLISH AND MONUMENT THE EXTERIOR BOUNDARY OF THE FOSTER A. ODOM TRUST PROPERTIES LYING IN SECTIONS 23, 24, AND 25 OF TOWNSHIP 1 NORTH, RANGE 22 EAST, W.M., GILLIAM COUNTY, AND IN SECTION 19 OF TOWNSHIP 1 NORTH, RANGE 23 EAST, W.M., MORROW COUNTY. PRIOR TO COMPLETING THE FIELD WORK AND MAPPING NECESSARY FOR THIS PROJECT, RESEARCH WAS MADE TO OBTAIN COPIES OF LEGAL DESCRIPTIONS FOR THE SUBJECT AND ADJOINING PROPERTIES AND TO OBTAIN COPIES OF PRIOR SURVEYS AND PLATS CONDUCTED ON OR IN THE VICINITY OF THE SUBJECT PROPERTIES. PRIOR SURVEYS UTILIZED AS A PART OF THE RESOLUTION SHOWN HEREON ARE LISTED AS REFERENCES.


IN THE FIELD, MONUMENTS WERE FOUND FROM THE REFERENCE SURVEYS, AS SHOWN. EXISTING MONUMENTATION PROVIDED THE EXTERIOR BOUNDARY FOR THE PROPERTY IN SECTION 19 IN MORROW COUNTY AND PROVIDED THE SOUTH LINE OF SECTION 25. THERE HAVE BEEN NO SURVEYS COMPLETED IN SECTIONS 23 AND 24 SUBSEQUENT TO THE ORIGINAL GLO SURVEY. IN THESE SECTIONS, SECTION AND 1/4 CORNERS WERE ESTABLISHED AT LONGSTANDING FENCE LINE AND BERM LINE INTERSECTIONS, AS SHOWN ON THE SURVEY, OR WERE CALCULATED BY PROPORTIONATE MEASUREMENT WHERE THERE WAS NO EVIDENCE FOR ESTABLISHMENT OF A CORNER LOCATION. ESTABLISHMENT OF CORNERS IN THIS FASHION WAS FOUND TO COMPARE WELL WITH GLO MEASURE AND TO GENERALLY CONFORM TO LONGSTANDING LAND USE PATTERNS. WHEN SUFFICIENT CORNER POSITIONS WERE ESTABLISHED TO RESOLVE THE BOUNDARIES OF THE SUBJECT PROPERTIES, SECTION SUBDIVISION WAS MADE PER STANDARD METHODS.

DETAILED LAND CORNER INFORMATION FOR ESTABLISHED CORNER POSITIONS IS SHOWN ON THE SURVEY. LAND CORNER RECORDS FOR ESTABLISHED SECTION, 1/4, AND CENTER 1/4 CORNERS WERE FILED SEPARATELY FROM THIS SURVEY.

WITH COMPLETION OF THE RESOLUTION OF THE BOUNDARY OF SUBJECT PROPERTY, MONUMENTS WERE SET, AS SHOWN, AT CORNER LOCATIONS AND POINTS ON LINE. SET MONUMENTS ARE 5/8" X 30" REBAR WITH YELLOW PLASTIC CAP INSCRIBED "B BESEDA PLS 50800" UNLESS NOTED OTHERWISE.

- 1) BASIS OF BEARING: BEARINGS SHOWN HEREON ARE BASED ON THE OREGON STATE PLANE COORDINATE SYSTEM, NORTH ZONE GRID, NAD 83 (1991) CORS (96) EPOCH 2002 BY GPS OBSERVATION ON THE FOUND MONUMENTS ON THE EAST LINE OF SECTION 25. USE THETA ANGLE OF 0°20'27" AT THE SOUTHEAST CORNER OF SECTION 23 TO ROTATE TO TRUE NORTH.
- 2) THE MONUMENTATION SHOWN HEREON WAS COMPLETED ON JANUARY 26, 2012.
