This survey is based on the ODOT survey and Drawing No. 09B-32-02 in Morrow County. The Bearing Base is as shown. I used the found ODOT monuments to calibrate to the ODOT Coordinate System. I re-established the lines as shown on the for both road alignments as shown on ODOT drawing. I then calculated the offsets to establish the boundaries of the Deeded and Abandoned portions of the alignment rights of ways. I finally established the combined total acreges that were to now be controlled by the Boardman Rural Fire Protection District and monumented those lines as shown on this Plat. I layed out the footprint of a proposed building for the District and the District then began construction of a new Fire Station. Even though I have listed the ODOT grid sytem that was shown on Drawing 9B-32-02 I used it only to reestablish the location of the centerline of the highway curve point locations. My final drawing is based on a local grid and the locations of all found monuments are based on actual surveyed locations, bearings, & distances.


