## HISTORY

The north line of T. 4S., R. 26E., W. M., was surveyed by George Williams under G. L. D. contract number 176, dated September 2,

The west line of T. 4S., R. 26E., W. M., and the subdivision of this township was surveyed by Zenas F. Moody under G. L. D. contract number 184, dated March 29, 1873.

## NARRATIVE

The purpose of this survey was to locate the boundaries of the SE1/4 of the NW1/4 of Section 7, T. 4S., R. 27E., W. M.

In order to perform this survey, all the controlling corners for the subdivision of Section 7 were searched for. The only corner evidence found was at the SW corner of Section 7.

The NW corner of Section 7 was set at single proportionate measure from the found corners 1 mile north and 1 mile south.

The NE corner of Section 7 was set at double proportionate measure from found corners 1 mile north, 1-1/2 miles south, 1/2 mile east and the proportioned position of the NW corner of Section 7.

The SE corner of Section 7 was set at double proportionate measure from found corners 2 miles north, 1/2 mile south, 1/2 mile east and the found SW corner of Section 7.

All of the 1/4 corners were set at single proportionate measure as required.

Section 7 was then subdivided in a normal manner.
