

A SURVEY LOCATED IN THE SE1/4 OF THE SE1/4 OF S27, TOWNSHIP 2 SOUTH, RANGE 26 EAST, W.M., LYING IN LOTS 6 AND 7 OF BLOCK 1, PRESTON LOONEY'S ADDITION TO THE CITY OF HEPPNER, MORROW COUNTY, OREGON.

NARRATIVE OF SURVEY

This survey was performed at the request of Mr. Leonard Hanna. The purpose of the survey was to locate and monument the boundaries of the land identified in Morrow County deed M-19646.

This property is a portion of Lots 7 and 12 of Preston Looney's Addition to the City of Heppner, the east line of which is the section line between Sections 26 and 27 as shown. I established that line from the found monuments from survey C-289-K. I established the point of beginning for the Hanna property at a distance of 42 feet south of the northeast corner of Lot 12 of Preston Looney's Addition as called for in the deed. Measuring south from the northeast corner of Lot 12 places the Hanna property 1/2 foot into the street right of way. The deed to the street was recorded in November of 1892 while the first deed to the Hanna property was recorded in January of 1893. However, the deed in Book I, Page 4, recorded in August of 1892 indicates that the land in the street had been conveyed to others before it was conveyed to the City as a street. The Catholic Church property is described as being measured southerly from the northeast corner of Lot 7 of Preston Looney's Addition. This description overlaps onto the northerly 6.5 feet of the Hanna property and appears to originate in Deed Book M. Page 43 first recorded in July of 1898. The possessory lines agree with the Hanna property description. The monuments set in this survey represent the description in the deed but no representation as to the correctness of the title is made hereby. The direction of the east - west lines for this survey are based on the south line of Preston Looney's Addition as represented in Partition Plats 2008-4 and 2012-11. The survey was performed with a combination of a Trimble R7/R8 RTK

GPS system and a Trimble 5601 Robotic Total Station.
