


This survey was performed at the request of Mr. Tony Doherty. The purpose of the survey was to locate, monument, and describe the

The monuments from survey B-930-E were found and confirmed. These monuments are in good agreement with the original GLO corner record and also the long term possessory lines. I have held them as the true corner points. I also used these existing monuments to confirm the location of the 1/4 corner between sections 33 and 34. The existing fence corner at that location shows the signs of long term occupation both with fences and farming to the east, and I therefore hold it as the best available evidence of the original corner position.

This survey was performed using a Trimble R7/R8 RTK GPS system.
