

SURVEY NARRATIVE

THIS REPLAT HAS BEEN PREPARED AT THE REQUEST OF RUSSEL ELLSWORTH TO RECONFIGURE LOTS 8 AND 9, BLOCK 5 OF THE HEPPNER HEIGHTS ADDITION INTO 3 PARCELS, AS SHOWN.

I MADE A VIGOROUS SEARCH FOR ORIGINAL MONUMENTS OF THE HEPPNER HEIGHTS ADDITION. THE RECORD SHOWS SETTING 1/2" RODS AND 1/2" PIPE. UNFORTUNATELY, I WAS UNABLE TO LOCATE ANY MONUMENTATION NOT ALREADY SHOWN IN THE RECORD. THE ROCKY GROUND AND SLOPED TERRAIN MAY BE TO BLAME. THE HILLS ARE ALSO FULL OF MAGNETIC ROCK; I PICKED UP ROCK LOCATIONS AT NEARLY EVERY CORNER SEARCHED. THERE HAVE ALSO BEEN MANY IMPROVEMENTS MADE AT, OR NEAR CORNER LOCATIONS, E.G., WALLS, GARAGES, NEW FENCING, ETC.

MONUMENTS FOUND THAT MAY BE ORIGINAL AND CANNOT BE CONFIRMED AS BEING SET BY A SURVEY OF RECORD INCLUDE THE 1-1/2" IRON PIPE AT THE SW CORNER OF LOT 9 AND THE 1/2" REBAR AT THE SE CORNER OF LOT 9 AS HELD IN SURVEY RECORD R5 AND ALSO ACCEPTED IN SURVEYS R6 AND R7; THE 1/2" REBAR NEAR THE NE CORNER OF LOT 9; THE 5/8" REBAR'S ON THE WEST LINE OF LOT 1, BLOCK 7 OF HEPPNER HEIGHTS, SHOWN AS MONUMENT'S "G" ON THIS SURVEY; MONUMENT "E", A 1/2" X 8" IRON PIPE; AND MONUMENT "J", A TIN CAN FULL OF CONCRETE.

I HELD THE 1-1/2" IRON PIPE AT THE SW CORNER OF LOT 9 (MONUMENT "A") AND THE 1/2" REBAR AT THE SE CORNER OF LOT 9 (MONUMENT "B") AS CONTROLLING IN THIS SURVEY. MONUMENTS FOUND FROM SURVEY R6 WERE USED TO ESTABLISH THE BEARING ALONG EAST LINE OF GILMORE STREET; THE RESULTING BEARING FITS WELL WITH MEASURED LOCATIONS OF THE CONCRETE RETAINING WALLS, GARAGES, AND HOMES ALONG THE EAST SIDE OF GILMORE STREET, WHEN HOLDING THE 1-1/2" IRON PIPE AT THE SW CORNER OF LOT 9. I HELD THE EAST LOT LINES AS PARALLEL WITH THE WEST LINE AT A DISTANCE OF 100 FEET, PER THE PLAT OF HEPPNER HEIGHTS, WHICH COINCIDES WITH THE MEASUREMENT BETWEEN AFOREMENTIONED MONUMENT'S "A" AND "B", AS SHOWN. THESE WERE THE BASIS FOR RECREATION OF LOT 9, HEPPNER HEIGHTS AS SHOWN.

I FOUND THE 1/2" REBAR NEAR THE NE CORNER OF LOT 9 TO BE OFF 1.29 FEET NORTHWESTERLY FROM THE COMPUTED POSITION AS SHOWN. WHEN SEARCHING FOR THIS MONUMENT, I UNINTENTIONALLY LOCATED A ±8" DUCTILE IRON WATER PIPE A FEW FEET AWAY FROM WHERE THE 1/2" REBAR WAS EVENTUALLY FOUND. THIS SAME WATER LINE WAS UNEARTHED IN SEARCHING FOR THE NW CORNER OF LOT 9. THERE IS NO DOUBT THAT IF A CORNER EXISTED AT THE NW CORNER OF LOT 9, IT WAS REMOVED BY THE PIPE INSTALLATION. I ALSO SUSPECT THAT THE REBAR AT THE NE CORNER MAY HAVE BEEN MOVED AND/OR DISTURBED BY THE PIPE INSTALLATION AS ITS POSITION DOES NOT MATCH THE RECORD WHEN HOLDING ACCEPTED MONUMENTS ALONG THE SOUTH LINE OF LOT 9. RECORD R3 HELD THIS 1/2" REBAR AS CONTROLLING, ALONG WITH THE 1/2" X 8" PIPE FOUND NEAR THE NW CORNER OF LOT 2, BLOCK 6 OF HEPPNER HEIGHTS. THIS CREATES AN OVERLAP OF HEPPNER HEIGHTS ONTO THE ADJOINING DIVISIONS OF JONES'S ADDITION AND MORROW'S 2ND ADDITION; AT WORST IT IS AROUND 1.3 FEET NEAR THE SOUTH BOUNDARY OF HEPPNER HEIGHTS AND PROGRESSIVELY GETS LESS AS YOU TRAVEL NORTHERLY UNTIL NEARLY NONEXISTENT NEAR THE NORTH BOUNDARY OF BLOCKS 5 & 6 OF HEPPNER HEIGHTS. FOR THESE REASONS | DID NOT HOLD THE FOUND MONUMENTS FROM RECORD R3.

TO ASSIST WITH MAKING THIS DETERMINATION, I ALSO TIED MONUMENTS ALONG THE EAST SIDE OF THOMPSON AVENUE AS SHOWN. I HELD THE 5/8" REBAR LOCATIONS ALONG THE WEST LINE OF LOT 1, BLOCK 7 OF HEPPNER HEIGHTS AS CONTROLLING, ALONG WITH MONUMENT "K" ALONG THE EAST LINE OF THOMPSON AVENUE AS SHOWN (HELD). THE RESULTING LINE ALSO FIT WELL IN RELATION TO THE PORTION OF THE PIONEER MEMORIAL HOSPITAL BUILDING AS CONSTRUCTED ON THE WEST RIGHT-OF-WAY LINE OF THOMPSON AVENUE.

THIS SURVEY WAS PERFORMED USING TWO TOPCON HIPER LITE+ GNSS UNITS OPERATED IN RTK MODE. THE BASIS OF BEARING IS NAD 83 (2011) STATE PLANE, OREGON NORTH ZONE, AS ESTABLISHED FROM GNSS OBSERVATIONS. DISTANCES SHOWN HAVE BEEN SCALED TO GROUND USING A CSF OF 1.00019314295807. UNITS ARE INTERNATIONAL FEET.
