

NARRATIVE

This partition plat was requested by Kim Cutsforth, on behalf of the Heppner Economic Development Corporation, to partition the land as described in Morrow County Deed Instrument 2018-42432.

The exterior boundary was surveyed by this firm in 2018 and is filed as Morrow County Map of Survey #2018-1843C.

The portion of Gilmore Street (Jail Street extended) between Balm Street and Cowins Street, was vacated by the City of Heppner, Ordinance #583-19 on June 10, 2019, recorded as Instrument #2022-50975 on April 4, 2022, in the Morrow County Deed Records.

The land is then partitioned at the direction of Ms. Cutsforth as shown herein.

Measurements are made utilizing Topcon HyperII GPS recievers.

SURVEYOR'S CERTIFICATE

I, Kenneth H. Delano Jr., Professional Land Surveyor registered in the State of Oregon, hereby certify that I have surveyed and monumented the parcels as shown herein, in accordance with O.R.S. 92., as described in Morrow County Deed Instrument 2018— 42432, and the portion of Gilmore Street as vacated by Ordinance #583-19, recorded as Instrument #2022-50975 in the Morrow County Deed Records, being more particularly described as follows:

A tract of land situated in the SW1/4 of Section 35, T.2S, R.26E., W.M., in the City of Heppner, Morrow County, Oregon as follows:

That portion of Lot 2 lying South of Willow Creek, and Lots 3, 4, 5 and 6 in Block 2 of the Jones Second Addition to Heppner.

TOGETHER WITH that portion of West Half of Cross Street, adjoining and lying on the East side of the above described tract, as vacated by Ordinance #242, recorded November 6, 1929 in Book 40, Page 239 of the Morrow County Deed Records.

TOGETHER WITH that portion of the East Half Gilmore Street, adjoining and lying on the West side of the above described tract, as vacated by Ordinance #583-19. recorded April 6/ 2022, as Instrument #2022-50975 in the Morrow County Deed Records.

Containing 0.70 acres, more or less.

Subject to the following:

- 1) An easement for a public sewer pipe, subject to the terms and conditions thereof, to the City of Heppner, recorded June 5, 1953 in Book 57, Page 24 in the Morrow County Deed Records, not shown due to insufficient description.
- 2) The rights of the public in and to that portion of said lands lying below the ordinary high water line of Willow Creek.

I hereby designate the pin at the intersection of the centerline of vacated Gilmore Street and the Northerly line of Cowins Street as the Initial Point for this Partition.

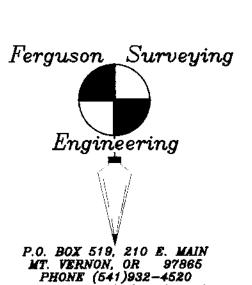
